## **Prediger Receives 2009 ACC Board Chair Award**

Alexandria, VA – The Airport Consultants Council (ACC) Board of Directors Chair Award was presented to Susan Prediger, Vice President with CAGE Inc., by 2009 Board Chair Evan Futterman at the ACC 31<sup>st</sup> Annual Conference & Exposition in Lake Las Vegas, NV.
